Twenty-one churches in the south of Egypt have received permission to rebuild their churches. Some had been waiting for a permit for more than twenty years. It had been virtually impossible to obtain a license to build a church in Egypt. Meanwhile, the Coptic community in Minya has seen many of their churches closed or set on fire.
