Church Planting in Niger

Niger is 97% Muslim and less than 1% Christian. There are regular reports of persecution against Christians from this nation of 19 million. Nevertheless, the Evangelical Church of Niger developed an ambitious goal to plant 52 new churches! Ask for the Lord to enable His children in Niger to go forth in boldness and insight, and for the nation to be transformed.

Nicaragua

The Nicaraguan National Conference is led by Rev. Juan Pavon. One the key focus of the conference is to encourage and mentor church planters. Ask that they will see much fruit as they creatively engage new parts of the country.

Liberia

The seven Liberian churches are the latest to join the UB denomination and led by Rev. Moses Somah. Pray that these churches and their leaders will continue to impact their communities strongly for Christ.
